The Village of Spring Valley Weed & Seed Program is an initiative that seeks to "weed" out criminal behavior and plant the "seeds" of prevention in our community. This Police / Community partnership is in its second year of operation and sponsors many gang prevention, youth development and parent engagement programs. The program includes a Safe Haven that is housed at the Martin Luther King Multi-purpose Center. There are several subcommittees at work, including Law Enforcement, Neighborhood Restoration and Economic Development, Treatment, Prevention and Intervention, Personnel and Finance and Sustainability.
